24 Resurrection Passages:

Job 19:25, 26 I know that my Redeemer is alive and shall stand on the earth

Matthew 27:51-53. Saints appear after the resurrection

Matthew 28:1-10. Resurrection appearance to the two Mary's

(Matthew 28:11-15). Guards false report

Matthew 28:16-20. Great Commission given in the Galilee.

Mark 16:1-8 Resurrection appearance to three women

(Mark 16:9-20). New Ending for Mark from other biblical sources

Luke 24:1-8. Two angels appear to unspecified number of women

Luke 24:9-12. Initial unbelief of the disciples

Luke 24:13-35. Appearance on the road to Emmaus

Luke 24:36-49. Second appearance to the apostles

Luke 24:50-53. First account of the ascension

John 20:1-10. Discovery of the empty tomb

John 20:11-18. Appearance to Mary of Magdala

John 20:19-23. Appearance to the apostles without Thomas
(initial reception of the Holy Spirit)

John 20:24-29. Thomas' testimony of the resurrection

(John 20:30,31). principle information given, not an exhaustive account

John 21:1-14. Appearance at the shores of the sea of Galilee.

John 21:15-19. Peter's triple affirmation to undo his triple denial

John 21:20-24. Peter told to mind his own business

(John 21:25). principle information given, not an exhaustive account

Acts 1:3-11. Second ascension account

I Corin. 15:1-9. Mention of multiple appearances

(I Corin. 15:10, 11). Intensity of Paul's ministry

Questions:

1. Did they buy the spices before or after the Sabbath?

Mark 16:1 (after). Luke 23:54-56 (before) Answer: John 19:31

2. Who guarded the tomb? Matt. 27:62-66 (28:11-15)
3. When was the veil of the temple ripped? Before or after the resurrection? Mark. 15:38 (Luke. 23:45) Matt. 27:51-53
4. Was there one earthquake or two? Matt. 27:51, 52 and Matt. 28:2
5. Was there one angel (Matt. 28:2; Mk. 16:5) or two (Lk. 24:4; John 20:12)
6. Why did they not recognize Him on the road to Emmaus?
7. Which passages in Moses, in the Prophets and in the Psalms did He show to them?
